

CLAUSE 11: ENTRY INTO FORCE, DURATION AND TERMINATION

- (1) This MOU shall enter into force on the date of signing.

[EDIGI SKILLS] shall undertake the following activities:


- I. The Second Party will give valuable inputs to the First Party in teaching/ training methodology so that the students fit into the industrial scenario meaningfully.
