
5. ARBITRATION





The Parties shall cooperate with each other and shall, as promptly as is reasonably practical, enter into all relevant agreements, deeds and documents as may be required to give effect to the actions contemplated in terms of this MoU.
- 2.4 The terms of cooperation shall be mutually decided between the Parties on case-to-case basis. This MoU shall represent the entire understanding as to the subject matter hereof and shall encompass any prior understanding between the Parties on the subject matter hereof.



3. SCOPE OF THE MoU

 Each Party agrees that it shall not, at any time, after executing the activities of this MoU, disclose any information in relation to these activities or the affairs of business or method of carrying on the business of the other without consent of bothParties.
- 3.12 It is expressly agreed that First Party and Second Party are acting under this MoU as independent entities, and the relationship established under this MoU shall not be construed as a partnership. Neither Party is authorized to use the other Party's name in any way, to make any representations or create any obligation or liability, expressed or implied, on behalf of the other Party, without the prior written consent of the other Party. NeitherParty shall have, nor represent itself as having, any authority under the terms of this MoUto make agreements of any kind in the name of or binding upon the other Party, to pledge theother Party's credit, or to extend credit on behalf of the other Party.

4. INTELLECTUAL PROPERTY

- 4.1 Nothing contained in this MoU shall, by express grant, implication, Estoppel or otherwise, create in either Party any right, title, interest, or license in or to the intellectual property (including but not limited to know-how, inventions, patents, copy rights and designs) of the other Party.
- 4.2 The rights of the First Party are reserved through the IPR Policy of the First Party. Notwithstanding anything, any consequence arising out of this MoU would not infringe/contravene any of the provisions of the IPR Policy of the First Party.
