DOCUMENT-II **RULES AND REGULATIONS OF THE SOCIETY**

1. Name of the Association: RATNAM INSTITUTE OF PHARMACY ALUMNI

ASSOCIATION

2. Address of the Office

: #Ratnam Institute of Pharmacy,

Pidathapolur, SPSR Nellore Dt.,

3. Place of operation

: Anywhere in India.

4. Membership

(1) It is open to all old and new students, staff of the college irrespective of caste, colour or creed and religion and to those who have completed

the age of 18 years and attained majority.

- (2) Every member shall pay an amount of Rs.250/- as membership fee at the time of admission. And each member shall pay Rs.500/- as annual subscription at beginning of every year. If it is not paid within three months from the date of commencement of the financial year, such member shall forfeit the membership. However Governing Body/ Executive Committee shall have power to fix membership fee at any time. After getting membership, the member shall abide by the rules and regulations of Associations.
- (3) Any member of the Society may resign his/her membership by notifying to the Secretary in writing with valid reasons.
- (4) The Executive Committee may at it's discretion take such action expulsion of a member in case the conduct or the activities of such member are found to be detrimental to the interests of the society

5. PATRONS:

Gentleman of status and rank may be invited by the Managing Committee to become Patrons and Vice Patrons and by paying donation as approved by the Executive Committee.

6. FORFEITURE OF MEMBERSHIP

- a. Those who resign in writing and whose resignations are accepted by the Executive Committee.
- b. Those who fail to attend three consecutive Executive Committee meetinas.

Any person shall be eligible to become an ordinary member of the Association that a person agree to abide by the Rules and Regulations of the Association and shall prefer to pay of Rs.200/- each may be paid towards membership fee, and a yearly subscription fee of Rs.100/collected for the maintenance of the Association. All the members shall pay the annual subscription before 10th March of every year. If not so, such member shall loose voting power. If such person wants to be enrolled again as fresh member, they can do so with the approval of the committee for the fresh membership.

7. FUNCTIONS OF THE SOCIETY:

- To be a world class institution to impart value and need based professional education to the Students and carving them into disciplined professionals.
- 2. To promote academic growth by offering state of the art and to generate new knowledge by engaging in cutting-edge research.
- 3. To enable the alumni to participate in activities which would contribute to the general development of the institute.
- 4. To organize and establish scholarship funds to help the needy and deserving students.
- 5. To provide a forum for the alumni for exchange of ideas on academic, cultural and social issues of the day.
- 6. To institute prizes and awards for outstanding project work, research papers or other professional activity by the students of the Institute; also to suitably recognize outstanding social and community service by the Alumni and the students.
- 7. To raise funds for various welfare and other schemes in the college as approved by the Association.
- 8. To arrange social and cultural functions.
- To plan and administer fund raising campaigns for improved facilities, library acquisitions, scholarships, faculty salary supplements and awards, etc.
- 10. To organize an alumni awards program for outstanding community and professional service.
- 11.To perform all other acts in furtherance of the objectives of the Association.

8.1. DUTIES OF THE OFFICE BEARERS:

a) PRESIDENT: The President shall be the Head of the Committee, of emergency rulings for some of orders, preside over all meetings and will do justice. He will keep all office records, furniture, and Documents related to the Association.

The Principal of the Ratnam Institute of Pharmacy will act as President.

b) <u>VICE PRESIDENT:</u> Vice President shall function as President in the absence of the President and also perform such functions as the President may delegate to him time to time

c) GENERAL SECRETARY:

- a. The General Secretary is the Chief Executive of the Society. The General Secretary shall be the person vested with the authority to sue or to be sued in Court of law in respect of any dispute or disputes concerning the Association provided always that the General Secretary is authorised to delegate this authority to any member or members nominated by her as may deem fit in the best interests of the Association.
- b. The General Secretary shall maintain a Register of Member.
- c. The General Secretary shall prepare and submit to the Execute Committee the Annual reports and get them ratified by the General Body at its annual General Body meeting.
- d. The General Secretary shall be the corresponding officer of the Association.
- e. The General Secretary shall maintain or cause to maintain the following books for the association cash books, minutes book, receipts and vouchers.
- f. The general secretary should attend to all correspondence relating to the society and its sister organization. All appointments under the society should be made by the general secretary and he may delegate such power to any officer bearers for specific period. All the assets and liabilities should be in the name of the institution represented by the name of general secretary. The general secretary is empowered to receive donations from the public and grants or remunerations from government and account for the society's accounts and spend the amount in the way in which he thinks best.
- g. The general secretary shall act as correspondent for the society as well as the educational institutions being run by the society.
- h. The general secretary has authorized to borrow loans from banks and financial institutions, execute required loan documents and to sign on behalf of the society.
- I. The General Secretary has authorised to acquire, purchase, utilise, sell and mortgage the movable and immovable properties of the Organisation on behalf of the Society.

- d) TREASURER: The Treasurer will maintain cash accounts on the funds of the committee, collect subscriptions, donations and grant and shall issue proper receipt, keep the money in bank which is recommended by the committee.
- e) **EXECUTIVE MEMBERS:** The Executive Members has to do the duties entrusted to them by the President from time to time as per the occasion demands, for the functioning if the Society with its activities.
- 9. GENERAL BODY MEETINGS: The General Body shall meet once in a year, i.e., in the month of March every year to learn the pass budget and elect the Managing Committee Members. The quorum for the General Body meeting 2/3rd of the members present at meeting. The Executive Committee shall meet once in every 3 months.

10. POWERS OF GENERAL BODY AND ITS FUNCTIONS:

- i. To elect the executive body.
- ii. To pass the budget, for ensuring year and to approve the expenditure statement of previous year.
- iii. To approve the activities of the society.
- iv. To appoint an Auditor, if necessary.
- v. General Body shall have powers to amend the rules and regulations of the Society.
- vi. The General Body is empowered to account or reject any fresh membership.
- vii. The quorum of the General Body meeting shall be 2/3rd of the members.

11. MANAGING COMMITTEE AND ITS FUNCTIONS:

- a. The Executive Committee shall consist of 09 members i.e., President, Vice President, Secretary, Treasurer and 5 Executive Committee Members. All these will be elected by the General Body for every three years.
- b. The Executive Committee should meet at least once in three months or on the day notified by the Secretary and compulsorily in the month of December to review the transactions of the society.
- c. If a vacancy arises in the Executive Body it can be filled in by Co-option by the Executive Committee.
- d. This body has the right to expel any member who violates the rules and regulations of the society and its ideals, without assigning any reason thereof.
- e. An annual budget will be presented by the Executive Committee to the General Body at the Annual General Body meeting.

- f. The Executive Committee shall have power to frame byelaws not inconsistent with the rules for the regulation of affairs of all sections of the Association subject to the approval of the General Body at its next meeting, in accordance with the provisions of A.P. Societies Registration Act 35 of 2001.
- g. The quorum of the Executive Body meeting shall be 2/3rd of the members present.
- h. To conduct and encourage programs in attainment of the Aims and Objects of the Society.
- i. To publish, print, produce, copy, edit, distribute, sell or purchase books, periodicals, magazines, journals, compendium, digests or any such matter which deserves to be disseminated for the benefit of public in general. and students in particular, in every media, including print, broadcast and electronic, or any other format found suitable.

12. THE GOVERNING BODY FUNCTIONS:

- To oversee the affairs of the projects/ project, programs implemented by the Society.
- ii. To accept donations, gifts, etc., from any source and seeks to any rightful means to arise funds for the Society.
- iii. To start, take over, maintain, develop and administer and control any development projects, programs and institutions.
- iv. To acquire or purchase assets and immovable properties for the Society.
- v. To mortgage or sell properties of the Society for the benefit of the Society.
- vi. To undertake any type of project or program for the welfare of the Society employee.
- vii. To consider amendments to Rules & Regulations, with the approval of the General Body members.

13. ELECTION AND NOMINATIONS:

- a. The First Executive Committee shall comprise of the signatories to the Memorandum of the Society.
- b. The Nominations for the Election to the Executive Committee may be sent at least Six weeks before the date of the General Body Meeting at which the election to be carried out
- c. The President of the Society shall formulate the method and procedure of Election at Every Meeting at which the Election is exercise.
- d. The Chairman of the General body shall be Election Officer.

- e. Every Member whose name appears in the register of members of the Society shall have One Vote at the General Body Meeting of the Society at which Election to the Executive Committee is Exercised. The Chairman of such General Body shall have a casting Vote in case of a tie.
- f. Officers shall be elected by simple majority at the General Body meeting.
- 14. QUORUM: The quorum of the body is 2/3rd Executive Committee Members.
- 15. <u>FUNDS</u>: The Funds collected if necessary shall be deposited in a bank authorised by the committee, on the name of the committee. Any withdrawals of money shall be made by the **Treasurer**, with the signature of the both **President and Treasurer** with the approval of the committee. In no way the funds of the committee would be mismanaged or misused. The invariant of the funds shall be in accordance with the provisions of section 1391(d) r.w.s.11(5) of the I.T. Act.
- 16. ACCOUNTS AND AUDIT: Proper books accounts shall be maintained by the Society. The accounts of the Society shall be maintained by the Secretary with the co-operation of the Joint Secretary. The accounts shall be closed on the 31st day of March each year and a Chartered Accountant shall audit it.
- 17. AMENDMENT: Any amendment shall be made unless it is admitted and then disbursed by the members of the general body so present for the purpose and then voted by 3/5th majority of members. And later on again after 30 days voted and confirmed by the same 3/5th majority of members so present at a second special meeting convened for this proposal.
- 18. WINDING UP: In case the said committee has to be wound up under any circumstances the matter may be admitted discussed in the General Body and it is found necessary doing so then allow the matter for voting. When the matter is voted and come out with 3/5th majority of members, and later on against after 30 days voted and confirmed by the same 3/5th majority of members so present at a second special meeting convened for the proposed.

In winding up of the committee the properties and funds relating to it that will regain after the full satisfaction of all the liabilities of the committee shall be transferred or paid or delivered to some other institution having similar aims and objectives. The committee shall have the power to modify or amend or cancel any of these rules and regulations subject to the provisions of the societies Registrations at 35/2001.

- 19. <u>LIABILITY:</u> The managing committee shall be responsible to discharge the debts etc., if any,.
- **20.** <u>LIQUIDATORS:</u> All the legal of fairs of the society movable and the immovable properties shall be settled u/s 26 of the A.P. Society Registration Act 35 of 2001 in the civil courts.
- 21. <u>DISPUTE:</u> In the event of any dispute arising among society in respect of any matter relating to the affairs of the society any member of the society may proceed with the dispute under the provisions as mentioned in the section 23 of A.P. Registration Act, 35 of 2001.
- **22.** FILING OF ANNUAL LIST: Every year the society shall, with in fifteen days from the date on which the general body meeting was held, furnished a list to the Registrar of Societies which shall contain the names and addresses of the members of the Managing Committee and officers entrusted with management of the affairs of the Society.



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


